During high season, Saint-Lary already welcomes a community of British skiers and riders, attracted by the South-West of France, a region easily accessible from Toulouse (via Easyjet) or Pau (via Ryanair). To make things even better, a free shuttle (1 hour journey) will link the station with Pau airport during the season 2008/2009.
